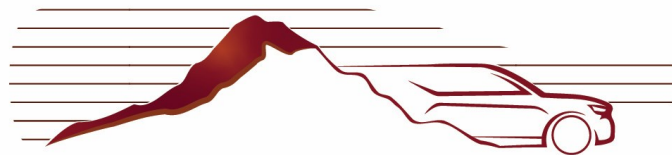

## Wine Flights & By the Glass

### Domestic Tasting Flight (\$35)

**2021 NORRIS DRY RIESLING RIBBON RIDGE, WILLAMETTE VALLEY)**                      **\$35 / \$12**

A dry style Riesling with soft texture balancing the acid. Barrel-fermented, spending 12 months on lees. This wine has delicate fruit notes of pineapple, apricot, and quince accompanied by floral and mineral characteristics.

**2021 J.C. SOMMERS, JOIE DE CHIEN PINOT NOIR (DUNDEE HILLS, WILLAMETTE VALLEY)**                      **\$27 / \$9**

The nose of this wine is an explosion of dark cherries, green tea leaves, dried rose petals and a whiff of wet poolside concrete. Flavors like quince, red rooibos tea and wild strawberries slip and slide across the palate. Modest tannins, silky texture and nice acidity seal the deal.

**2021 NORRIS ESTATE PINOT NOIR (RIBBON RIDGE, WILLAMETTE VALLEY)**                      **\$55/ \$19**

A multiclonal blend of the vineyard site. Minerality with wild flowers and baking spices on the nose. Dark fruited on the palate highlighted by plum and pomegranate on the finish.

**2021 BREWER-CLIFTON, SANTA RITA HILLS (SANTA RITA HILLS, CALIFORNIA)**                      **\$48 / \$16**

Aromas of pomegranate, white tea, raspberry with flavors of dried fig, truffle and ripe cherry with hints of rooibos tea.

**2021 HARTFORD COURTLANDS EDGE VINEYARDS PINOT NOIR (SONOMA COAST, CALIFORNIA)**                      **\$50/ \$17**

Leads with aromas of red and black cherry, pomegranate, and dried rose petal. The layered flavors of dark berries, plum and licorice lead to a mid-palate with elegant and polished texture. The wine ends with a lingering mocha and mineral finish.

### International Additional Flight (\$15)

**2021 PEYRASSOL ROSE COTE de PROVENCE (CUVEE des COMMNADEURS FRANCE)**                      **\$27 / \$10**

A blend of Cinsault, Grenache, Syrah, and Rolle. Brilliant salmon skin color. Fresh and focused on the nose, displaying vibrant strawberry, nectarine and melon scents and a spicy touch of white pepper. Silky and open-knit, showing good depth and energy to its juicy pit fruit and red berry flavors. A hint of orange zest lends bite to the juicy finish, which hangs on very good tenacity.

**2022 PAZO das BRUXAS, ALBARINO (DOS RIAS BAIXA, SPAIN)**                      **\$27/ \$9**

Luminous and clear straw color. Clean and intense floral aromas with deliciously ripe citrus notes (pineapple preserves). Rich and flavourful, with lush extract and a seductive midpalate.

**2020 TE MATA, SYRAH (HAWKE'S BAY , NEW ZEALAND)**                      **\$30/\$10**

This Syrah showcases the delightful floral aromas and supple texture that Hawke's Bay's climate famously introduces to Syrah's satisfying spicy dark berry flavors.

**2018 HICKINBOTHAM, THE REVIVALIST (MCLAREN VALE AUSTRALIA)**                      **\$62/\$21**

From the violet and red flower perfume to the soulful earthy aromas, ripe fresh plum fruit flavors and suave fleshy tannins, with carefully layers of complexity. The resounding freshness and lively acid structure ensures this wine is a lively, energetic and mouth-filling expression of Merlot.

# Sparkling

- NV GRAHAM BECK BRUT ROSE SOUTH AFRICA** **\$28**  
Made from the traditional Méthode Cap Classique base wines of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, its unique silver-pink hue is obtained by an enzymatic reaction during the transport of the Pinot Noir fruit to the cellar. The fine, lively mousse is brisk on the palate, showing hints of oyster shell, fresh lavender and subtle hints of berry and cherry.
- NV CHAMPAGNE DUMENIL PREMIER CRU, (BLANC DE NOIRS, CHAMPAGNE FRANCE)** **\$65**  
Delicate mousse with aromas of red fruit, grilled almonds, quince and plums. On the palate notes of raspberry and crushed strawberry. A rich texture, a superb balance between substance and vivacity, with a delicate biscuity finish.
- NV JP CHENET ORIGINAL BRUT BLANC de BLANCS VIN de France** **\$16**  
Clear, golden body with green highlights and many fine bubbles. A light fruity bouquet with white fruit notes and brioche hints. A fresh and fruity palate with apricots and white peach.

# Domestic Whites

- 2020 FREEMARK ABBEY CHARDONNAY (NAPA CALIFORNIA)** **\$40**  
Aromas of apple cobbler, crème Brule, ripe pineapple, orange marmalade, and fresh peach. The palate is supple, balanced and integrated and exhibits flavors of stone fruit, candied lemon zest, baking spices, ambrosia and vanilla.
- 2020 BERGSTROM WINES OLD STONES (WILLAMETTE VALLEY)** **\$48**  
Pale in color. Driven by aromas of crushed oyster shell, lemon verbena, and nectarines. Mineral expression carries through on the palate that bursts with flint and citrus oils. A vibrant and refreshing acidity integrates beautifully with the structured richness of oak, brioche, and stone fruit flavors to create a lasting succulent finish.
- 2022 MATANZAS CREEK WINERY SAUVIGAN BLANC (SONOMA COUNTY CALIFORNIA)** **\$21**  
Aromas of honeydew melon, white peach and guava are met with key lime blossom and nectarine on the palate.
- 2021 COLEMAN VINEYARDS PINOT GRIS (MCMINNVILLE WILLAMETTE VALLEY)** **\$24**  
Fermented in French new acacia & neutral oak barrels, cocci pesto terracotta amphora, and stainless steel, the site is known for expressing bright and savory fruit. One is immediately greeted with peaches, lychee, fresh brine, and honey crisp apple. There is racy mid-palate acidity and a lush, toasty honey malt finish.
- 2018 MAGGY HAWK SKYCREST VINEYARD CHARDONNAY (ANDERSON VALLEY CALIFORNIA)** **\$55**  
Focused, fresh and bright. The 2018 Skycrest Vineyard Chardonnay offers a complex mix of citrus, tropical and stone fruit that can only be achieved from this elevation. The unique blend of white peach, papaya, lemon tart and floral aromas blend seamlessly into a light and fresh palate of Cara Cara Orange, almond and hints of ground ginger. The acidity is laser focused throughout the wine and highlights the incredible texture and delightfully long finish.
- 2021 NORRIS DRY RIESLING (RIBBON RIDGE WILLAMETTE VALLEY)** **\$35**  
A dry style Riesling with soft texture balancing the acid. Barrel-fermented, spending 12 months on lees. This wine has delicate fruit notes of pineapple, apricot, and quince accompanied by floral and mineral characteristics.
- 2021 DENISON CELLARS EOLA SPRINGS VINEYARD CHARDONNAY (EOLA HILLS WILLAMETTE VALLEY)** **\$45**  
A ripe and flavorful white with baked apples, grilled pineapple and some salted sourdough on the nose. Cloves, too. Full-bodied yet bright, with spicy layers. 70 cases produced.
- 2021 PATRICIA GREEN CELLARS SAUVIGNON BLANC (WILLAMETTE VALLEY)** **\$30**  
This wine is varietally correct in all the best possible ways; aromatically intense, dry but with sweet fruit, textured without being heavy as well as being elegant.

# Rose

- 2021 PEYRASSOL ROSE COTES de PROVENCE CUVÉE des COMMANDEURS (FRANCE) \$27**  
A blend of Cinsault, Grenache, Syrah, and Rolle. Brilliant salmon skin color. Fresh and focused on the nose, displaying vibrant strawberry, nectarine and melon scents and a spicy touch of white pepper. Silky and open-knit, showing good depth and energy to its juicy pit fruit and red berry flavors. A hint of orange zest lends bite to the juicy finish, which hangs on very good tenacity.
- 2022 DENISON CELLARS JOHNSON RIDGE ROSE OF PINOT NOIR (WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$24**  
Johnson Ridge Vineyard Rosé of Pinot Noir was produced from fruit harvested specifically for rosé, with a focus on ripe skins and flavors. This wine is deep salmon in color, featuring enticing flavors and aromas of Rainier cherry, nectarine, with hints of pomegranate and ripe strawberry.

# International Whites

- 2017 CAPENSIS FLAGSHIP CHARDONNAY (WESTERN CAPE SOUTH AFRICA) \$75**  
Grilled pineapple, dried mango, spiced pear, buttered toast and smoked almond on the nose. Medium to full-bodied, layered and concentrated.
- 2022 PAZO das BRUXAS, ALBARINO (DO RIAS BAIXA SPAIN) \$ 27**  
Luminous and clear straw color. Clean and intense floral aromas with deliciously ripe citrus notes (pineapple preserves). Rich and flavourful, with lush extract and a seductive midpalate.
- 2021 DOMAINE ALARY La GRANGE DANIEL ROUSSANNE vin de PAYS LA PRINCIPAUTE de ORANGE (SOUTHERN RHONE FRANCE) \$24**  
The nose is fresh and pleasant with notes of honey and white flowers. The palate is crisp and mineral with expressive notes of honey and acacia, and a dry, harmonious finish.

# Domestic Pinot Noir

- 2021 HARTFORD COURTLANDS EDGE VINEYARDS PINOT NOIR (SONOMA COAST CALIFORNIA) \$50**  
Leads with aromas of red and black cherry, pomegranate, and dried rose petal. The layered flavors of dark berries, plum and licorice lead to a mid-palate with elegant and polished texture. The wine ends with a lingering mocha and mineral finish.
- 2017 BERGSTROM WINES SILICE CHEHALEM MOUNTAIN PINOT NOIR (WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$105**  
The aromatic profile is not unlike a complex potpourri of fruits, spices, and herbs mixed with a saline note that makes the finish succulent and juicy. This is whole-cluster Pinot Noir at its finest. This wine is ripe, round and velvety, but also possesses the acidity and tannins of the vintage, much like a marionberry or boysenberry, which sew it up nicely in a very approachable wine now, but will also benefit from time in the cellar.
- 2021 FURIOSO FIVE PEAKS PINOT NOIR (WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$56**  
Brimming with boysenberry, red apple skin, sour cherry, and cinnamon, this wine gives us a rustic and brambly quality that is both lush and uniquely Oregon. The palate offers tart blueberry and huckleberry with notes of fresh juniper and rosemary. A texturally complex wine, the Five Peaks Pinot Noir promises to become even more exuberant with 1-2 years aging
- 2019 ALEXANA WINERY REVANA VINEYARD ESTATE PINOT NOIR (DUNDEE HILLS WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$65**  
Satiny and multilayered, with floral raspberry and pomegranate flavors that are laced with fresh violet and toasty spice notes.
- 2017 WILLAKENZIE EMERY PINOT NOIR (YAMHILL-CARLTON WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$85**  
Multilayered and complex, with notes of black cherry, lilac, and forest floor. This wine offers depth, richness and tremendous length

- 2019 BEAUX FRERES BEAUX FRERES PINOT NOIR (RIBBON RIDGE WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$100**  
A darker, more forward expression with candy-coated aromatics and red strawberry seed notes rising from evergreen spice, damp loamy soil, and plum sauce, perfumed earth, and silky yet firm tannin.
- 2018 ZENA CROWN VINEYARD CONIFER PINOT NOIR ( EOLA-AMITY WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$90**  
Offering verve and persistence, this Pinot is taut at first but slowly blooms into dynamic blueberry and black cherry flavors that are accented by forest floor and spice tea
- 2019 ZENA CROWN CONIFER PINOT NOIR (EOLA-AMITY WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$90**  
Vivacious red fruit twirling ruthlessly on the entry, the 2019 Conifer has the power of early summer sunlight with the tenderness and warmth of a random act of kindness. Peak summer ponderosa pine forest, baked earth, tulips, and cedar dust give way to mandarins and allspice on the palate. Notes of peak ripe berries and cocoa lead to a broad, acid driven finish.
- 2019 ZENA CROWN SUM PINOT NOIR (EOLA-AMITY WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$90**  
A massed from multiple vineyard blocks and clones, this wine has turbulent wavy texture like a class III river rapid running perpendicular to the tongue. Across the mid-palate and to the finish, the wine takes on pixelated texture of medium sized river rock moving toward a din of whitewater noise. Expressing Autumn, the 2019 Σ (The Sum) leads with cracked black pepper, leaf duff, allspice, and brown sugar on the nose, with everlasting bramble on the finish. 50% whole-cluster fermentation bolsters the wine, sustaining the tannic imprint with wavy texture on the finish
- 2019 ZENA CROWN VINEYARD SLOPE PINOT NOIR (EOLA-AMITY WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$115**  
At the Slope, the Zena Crown Vineyard shifts to face primarily south, encouraging perfect ripeness and maximum phenolic development. Symbolizing a dark winter's night, Slope has a quiet entry that crescendos rapidly with the energy of a stallion. The wine has aromas of spearmint, plumb reduction sauce, and white puffy clouds with flavors of barely ripe red fruit, rich umami, and lightly roasted coffee
- 2018 ZENA CROWN BLOCK 14 PINOT NOIR (EOLA-AMITY WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$115**  
Pure, pristine, and crisp up front, the 2018 Block 14 displays incredible persistence with linear lines flowing beautifully across the palate. Aromas of perfectly ripe Japanese plum, tangerine, prickly pear cactus, and watermelon lead to flavors of infused green tea, serviceberry, and rose hips. This Pinot Noir is structurally significant, with snappy tannins on the side of al dente.
- 2021 BREWER-CLIFTON, SANTA RITA HILLS PINOT NOIR ( SANTA RITA HILLS CALIFORNIA) \$48**  
Aromas of pomegranate, white tea, raspberry with flavors of dried fig, truffle and ripe cherry with hints of rooibos tea.
- 2021 NORRIS RESERVE PINOT NOIR (RIBBON RIDGE WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$65**  
Exhibits depth, restraint and age ability. Stony minerality backed by Rainer cherries and hood strawberries. A structured wine.
- 2021 NORRIS ESTATE PINOT NOIR (RIBBON RIDGE WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$55**  
A multiclonal blend of the vineyard site. Minerality with wild flowers and baking spices on the nose. Dark fruited on the palate highlighted by plum and pomegranate on the finish.
- 2021 NORRIS COURY PINOT NOIR (RIBBON RIDGE WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$48**  
Structured by stem inclusion and fine grain tannin. This wine showcases a wide bouquet of cherry cola, blood orange and loose tea leaves. A plush wine with a playful palate weight.
- 2019 COLEMAN VINEYARDS PINOT NOIR OLD BLOCK POMMARD (MCMINNVILLE WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$45**  
Garnet charm leads to cherry juice, crisp Santa Rosa plum and starfruit, delicate floral and graphite notes, and a suggestion of cola. Silk crepe tannins drape across the palate and the juicy, ample finish
- 2018 COLEMAN VINEYARDS PINOT NOIR ESTATE RESERVE (MCMINNVILLE WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$45**  
Baking spice and sweet cherry crostata, braised apple and late season fruits are in harmony with early season bright notes of rhubarb and strawberry and cedar forest. The tannins are fine-grained yet give something to chew on

- 2019 COLEMAN VINEYARDS PINOT NOIR ESTATE RESERVE (MCMINNVILLE WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$45**  
Purple garnet robed chocolate-covered cherries burst with juice and jazzy five-spice. Like a satin trimmed velvet dinner jacket this wine is styled for a night out. That is to say, that the tannins are finessed and there are layers of interest with generous length to the finish.
- 2019 COLEMAN VINEYARDS PINOT NOIR DEER RUN 115 (MCMINNVILLE WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$45**  
Dark chocolate dipped strawberries are complimented with exotic cedar and violet notes as the wine complexes purple on the palate with blackberry and elderberry, green olive, and sculpted faille tannins
- 2018 DENISON CELLARS KIFF PINOT NOIR (YAMHILL - CARLTON WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$45**  
The nose is filled with robust richness fueled by inclusion of Pommard clone. Notes of brown spices, cocoa blend with bright red fruit on the palate entry with a core of mineral, rhubarb and herb. Nicely defined structure with notable balance.
- 2018 DENISON CELLARS JOHNSON RIDGE PINOT NOIR (EOLA - AMITY WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$45**  
The nose is clay, loam and a sweet singed cedar with waxy crushed red berry. The palate entry is strawberry and hard red cherry with a lively-textured exuberance in the core of plum and blue fruits. Persistent palate expression of finely-balanced acidity. 20% New Oak
- 2018 DENISON CELLARS TÊTE DE CUVÉE (WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$75**  
Raised in only 7% new French oak. The nose is crumbled stones, vanilla bean, blue plums and vine berries punctuated with an underlying crisp herb. The palate entry is a firm and penetrating mineral and spice with a gorgeous, sculpted mid-palate of harmonious black and dark red stone fruits finishing with nicely integrated bright acidity.
- 2021 DENISON CELLARS (WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$32**  
Ripe red fruit notes of cherry and raspberry accompanied by fig, spice and violet. Flavors of cherry, baking spices, vanilla and cola. Lovely bright acid balances the soft tannins and continues on the palate for a long finish.
- 2021 J.C. SOMERS, JOIE DE CHIEN PINOT NOIR (DUNDEE HILLS WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$27**  
The nose of this wine is an explosion of dark cherries, green tea leaves, dried rose petals and a whiff of wet poolside concrete. Flavors like quince, red rooibos tea and wild strawberries slip and slide across the palate. Modest tannins, silky texture and nice acidity seal the deal
- 2014 DUSKY GOOSE PINOT NOIR (DUNDEE HILLS WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$75**  
A careful blend of Dijon 115, Dijon 777, Dijon 828 & Pommard clones. Gently aged in French oak for 12 months and reserved for additional bottle aging before release, our Dundee Hills Pinot Noir is made to endure, building power with age. Notes of dusty rose, dark cherry, and anise with an elegant, smooth finish.
- 2021 KEN WRIGHT, AVA SERIES PINOT NOIR (EOLA-AMITY HILLS WILLAMETTE VALLEY) \$47**  
Dark notes of juicy blackberry, ripe plum and blueberry. Generous and lingering on the finish with notes of orange peel and hibiscus.

## International Pinot Noir

- 2020 PHILIPPE JOUAN COTEAUX BOURGUIGNONS PINOT NOIR CÔTES DE NUITS (BURGUNDY FRANCE) \$56**  
Fresh, floral, and herb-accented bouquet. Beautiful, pure red fruit tending toward berries over cherries, with really bright acidity and supple tannins

## Heavy Reds Domestic

- 2018 FREEMARK ABBEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON (RUTHERFORD NAPA CALIFORNIA)** **\$85**  
Aromas of brambly black fruits, cedar shavings, milk chocolate, graphite and forest floor. The palate is complex and richly textured with flavors of blackberry, coffee, cigar box, and cassis. The tannins are dusty yet well rounded and integrated.
- 2002 FREEMARK ABBEY 'SYCAMORE' CABERNET SAUVIGNON (RUTHERFORD NAPA CALIFORNIA)** **\$350**  
Aromas of blackberries, boysenberries, black currant, dark cherries, with cinnamon, clove, dark chocolate, and a hint of lavender. Smooth full dark cherry flavors reminiscent of a dark chocolate/cherry truffle, yet not sweet but with a wonderful, inviting, pleasant balance.
- 2017 HARTFORD COURT, OUTER LIMITS VINEYARD SYRAH (SONOMA COAST CALIFORNIA)** **\$54**  
Leads with aromas of red and black cherry, pomegranate, and dried rose petal. The layered flavors of dark berries, plum and licorice lead to a mid-palate with elegant and polished texture. The wine ends with a lingering mocha and mineral finish.
- 2018 ALKI WINES MERLOT (COLUMBIA VALLEY WASHINGTON)** **\$22**  
An inviting nose of ripe strawberries with hints of blueberry. Bramble fruit and blackcurrant notes on the palate with some peppery spice on the finish
- 2017 FIVE STAR SUPERNOVA (WALLA WALLA WASHINGTON)** **\$54**  
The beautiful colors of crimson and magenta draw you in. Aromas of orange blossom, raspberry, roast beef and fresh jalapeno. The acid is bright, and the finish is long and savory. It is fruity and meaty.

## Heavy Reds International

- 2018 TENUTA DI ARCENO CHIANTI CLASSICO RISERVE (ITALY)** **\$40**  
Rich fruit aromas of ripe plum, floral notes of honeysuckle and earthy hints of forest floor. An incredibly silky palate carries through the beautiful balance of fruit and earth flavors with dominate notes of bright red cherries and dark chocolate. The finish is long and intriguing showcasing classic notes of orange peel with undertones of cedar and tobacco.
- 2016 VALADORNA RED BLEND (TUSCANY ITALY)** **\$50**  
Earthy with notes of cypress, vanilla bean, and spice. There are deep fruit flavors of black cherries, plums and blueberries followed by pleasant hints of chocolate and dried rose petals. On the palate, the tannins are chewy and accompanied by lively acidity: contributing to a long finish fominated by flavors of dried figs and licorice.
- 2019 LES CADRANS DE LASSÈGUE, SAINT-EMILION GRAND CRU (BORDEAUX FRANCE)** **\$30**  
A bright wine bursting with crunchy red fruit, nutmeg and white pepper. Cabernet Franc lends spice and polish to the dense core of fruit on the palate, well-balanced with discrete tannins and an uplifting tension. A long and mineral finish reveals the clay and limestone terrior.
- 2018 DOMAINES ANDRÉ AUBERT, LA SÉRINE (CÔTES DU RHÔNE FRANCE)** **\$20**  
An inviting nose of ripe strawberries with hints of blueberry. Bramble fruit and blackcurrant notes on the palate with some peppery spice on the finish
- 2020 BRUNA GRIMALDI NEBBIOLO D'ALBA (PIEDMONT ITALY)** **\$27**  
Shows floral aromas with hints of ripe fruit and spice. On the palate, elegant tannins blend with the structure and find a harmonious balance
- 2017 FEDERICO PATERNINA, RIOJA BANDA AZUL CRIANZA (RIOJA SPAIN)** **\$27**  
The Bande Azul is a traditionally-styled Rioja with black fruits balanced by integrated leather notes, vanilla oak, and good structure

- 2019 DOMAINE LA BÉRANGERAIE, CUVÉE MAURIN (CAHORS FRANCE) \$25**  
Some say the birthplace of Malbec. Ripe cassis and elderberry fill the nose and mouth, and the juicy and expansive palate impression is supported by fine-grained tannins with a long finish of black fruit, black pepper, and humus.
- 2021 MAAL, BIUTIFUL MALBEC-CAMPO LOS ANDES (MENDOZA ARGENTINA) \$25**  
A pure Malbec that does not see oak in any part of the winemaking process and is fermented in cement vats without additions or corrections. Dark and red fruit notes accompanied by floral, chocolate and some minerality.
- 2020 TE MATA, SYRAH (HAWKE'S BAY NEW ZEALAND) \$30**  
This Syrah showcases the delightful floral aromas and supple texture that Hawke's Bay's climate famously introduces to Syrah's satisfying spicy dark berry flavors.
- 2020 IL FAUNO DI ARCANUM 'SUPER TUSCAN' (TUSCANY ITALY) \$40**  
The nose reveals aromas of juicy fresh strawberries and raspberries with hints of menthol. The palate is filled with flavors of ripe plums and bright cherries as well as floral tones of rose and hints of honeysuckle. Chewy tannins are framed by lively acids.
